Do you love working with children and exploring ways to evolve environments to be inclusive? Then we have the perfect fit for you! We are seeking Inclusion Instructors for our Summer Camps. Under the direction of the Team Leader, Inclusion Instructors will provide support to children with behavioural needs and/or disabilities while ensuring the safety and well-being of all participants. Training will be held June 12 (6-9pm) and June 15 (9am-4pm), this is a paid session and must be attended.
Oak Bay Parks, Recreation and Culture offers an additional 14% in pay per hour in lieu of benefits for auxiliary employees, a staff facility pass that provides access to our weightroom, pool, skating rink, and drop-in fitness classes (granted with a regularly scheduled weekly shift). Oak Bay offers opportunities for advancement and growth within our organization.

RESPONSIBILITES

- Planning and adapting daily schedule of activities suitable for a child/children who require additional support.
- Liaise with children, parents/guardians, program staff, and community partners in friendly manner.
- Developing lesson plans, sensory projects, care plans and documenting the child's progress.
- Ability to work without direct supervision.
- Adhere to all safety standards for protection of all participants.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Previous experience working with children behavioural needs.
- Ability to work as an effective team member.
- Experience working directly with children with behaviour difficulties, disabilities and/or additional support needs in a recreational environment.
- Provision of valid COVID-19 proof of vaccination (due to the nature of this position, the Vancouver Island Health Authority mandatory vaccination policy is applicable and requires the submission of valid proof or full vaccination status against COVID-19 as a condition of employment)
- Current Emergency First Aid and CPR-C.
- Provision of a current Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening (Note: This is the applicant's financial responsibility to obtain this).
