Tour Thousands of Years of Indigenous History
Oak Bay began erecting monuments honouring Salish history and culture in 2008. The Xaxe Tensew Sacred Land Society initiated this project. The Salish artist is master carver Charles Elliott, Tseweng.

- 4 1327 Beach Dr (marina) Turkey Head, known as Spewhung was an ancient village site.
- 5 528 Island (in Anderson Hill Park) Anderson Hill
- 6 568 Beach Dr (across street from) Kitty Islet
- 7 200 Beach Dr (across in park) McNeill Bay, (Chikawich)
- 8 Sahsima Rock, Chinese Cemetery

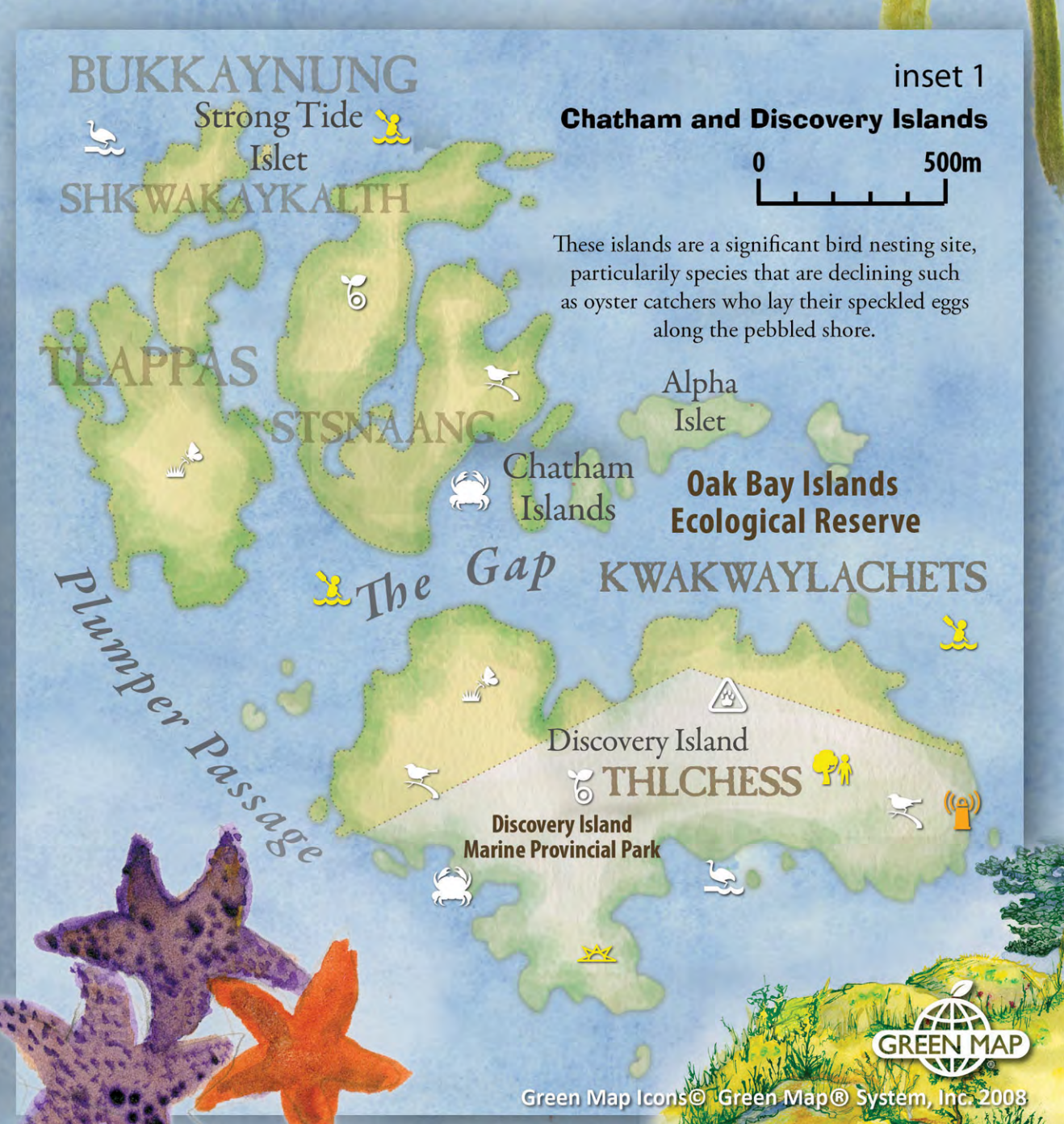
