



BY-LAW NO. 1557

A By-law to regulate the affixing and displaying of house numbers.


The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Oak Bay hereby enacts as follows:

- 1 The owner of every building in the Municipal District of Oak Bay, other than out-buildings and ancillary buildings upon the same lot as the main building, shall affix and keep affixed upon such building in a conspicuous place as near as practicable to the front entrance of such building, a street number allotted to such building by the Engineer of the said Corporation.
- 2 In the event that such building is separated by a fence or hedge from the street, the owner shall affix and keep affixed, in a conspicuous place at the entrance through such fence or hedge, a duplicate of the street number allotted to such building.
- 3 Each street number shall be of an easily legible size and design, and the owner of the premises upon which the same is affixed shall not allow the same to be or become obscured by vegetation or otherwise.
- 4 Any person or corporation found guilty on summary conviction of offending against the provisions of this By-law shall be liable to a penalty of Ten dollars (\$10.00) for each such offence, and the continuance after conviction of a breach of this By-law shall be deemed a new offence for each day on which the same is continued and shall be punishable accordingly.
- 5 This By-law may be cited as the "House Numbering By-law 1948".
