Painted Pianos

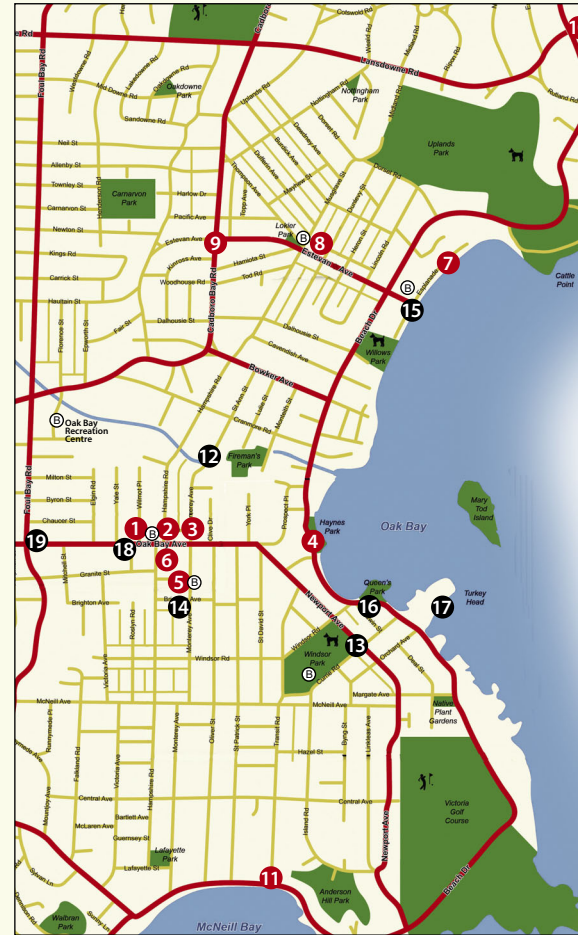


Six pianos painted by local artists will return this summer for the public to play and enjoy!
