HIRING PROCESS

- Shortlisted applicants will be contacted by email by Friday, January 31. Interviews will be conducted between February 4-7.
- 2. Only shortlisted applicants will be required to provide an original Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening dated within one year, to be presented to Human Resources by Friday, February 28. (Note: It is the applicant's financial responsibility to obtain this)
- 3. Training will be held between March 4-12. This is a mandatory paid session.
- 4. Short-listed applicants (including current staff) will be required to bring original certificates to the interview. Specific certifications required are listed with each position.
