- 4. If you are under the age of 16 your parent/guardian is required to complete the Parent/Guardian Consent Form found on the Oak Bay Parks, Recreation & Culture Employment website page.

We regret that only shortlisted applicants will be contacted. Late applications will be considered after applications received by closing date are processed.

### **HIRING PROCESS**

- 1. Shortlisted applicants will be contacted by email by start of April 2025.
- 2. Interviews will be conducted between April 8-10. Team Leader candidates will be contacted for a second interview during April 14.
- 3. Only shortlisted applicants will be required to provide an original Police Information Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening dated within one year, to be presented to Human Resources by the specified date in the request email. (Note: It is the applicant's financial responsibility to obtain this)
- 4. Short-listed applicants (including current staff) will be required to bring original certificates to the interview. Specific certifications required are listed with each position.
- 5. Successful applicants will be offered positions by e-mail between April 24-May 31.

### TRAINING PROCESS

- Training will be held in person Wednesday, June 11 (evening), Wednesday, June 18 (evening), and Saturday, June 14 (all day). Additional training may be required based on program/camp needs.
- 2. Some positions require staff to be available for up to 15 hours of camp specific lesson planning and training in addition to the training listed above. These sessions will take place in early June and will be held in the evenings. Team Leaders will contact their staff to arrange times and dates.

### AQUA ADVENTURES & JR. AQUA ADVENTURES

Weekly registered camp for ages 7-12 years old. This out trip based camp focuses on aquatic recreational activities that may include skim boarding, kayaking, and beach trips.


### **TENNIS**


