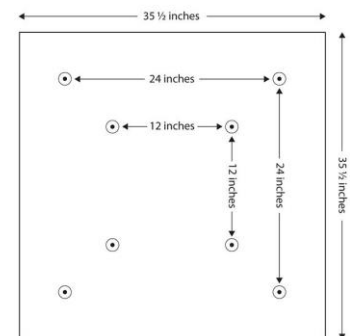
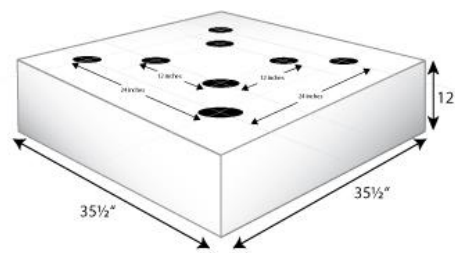


Sculpture Installation Guidelines

All sculptures need to be made of a durable material for the yearlong outdoor ocean side setting and constructed with safety in mind for display in a public setting.

- All sculptures must be securely fastened to the concrete base provided.
 - Bases are 35 ½" square, 12" high
 - Approximate weight of base is 800 lbs
 - 5/8" bolts are 12"x12" on centre and 24"x24" on centre



- A plate or strips of steel, or other suitable material should be attached to the sculpture.
 - Holes on the plate should accommodate a 5/8" bolt. This can be integral to the sculpture or a platform or pedestal that the sculpture will be securely attached to.
 - If your plate will be hidden or in an enclosure, please make sure it is accessible to allow for tools and tightening.

- For works under 36" in height – consider incorporating a plinth or base to bring work up to viewer eyeline.
- Metal sculptures should be sealed/powder-coated to avoid rust bleeding onto pedestal or pad.

A sign will be created with artist and sponsor information to accompany each sculpture.
