- Assists the Coordinator in ensuring that procedures and established performance and safety standards and emergency
  procedures are followed met for the general public and all staff members;
- Keeps the Coordinator well informed and acts in their absence if required;
- May act in the capacity of Team Leader, which includes on-deck hours.
- Supervises the issuance, use, care, and maintenance of first aid supplies, aquatic supplies, and equipment.
- Promotes and participates in maintaining good relationships with aquatic interest groups and the general public.
- Programs public swims with themes to attract attendance and active participation.
- Attends staff meetings, workshops and seminars as required.
