- Ensures cleanliness of washrooms, change rooms and showers daily.
- Keeps clear and safe Sweeps all outside walks and entryways on a regular basis.
- Sets up tables, chairs and program equipment daily as per the facility schedule.
- Ensures a good stock of supplies is always available.
