WHAT'S HAPPENING AT MONTEREY?

July Monterey Centre Facility Closure July 2 to August 4, 2025

We're excited for a fully updated Reception centre, new kitchen flooring and other necessary updates to the facility.

The Centre will reopen on Tuesday, August 5, 2025

Members with an active Social Activity Membership at the time of the facility closure will receive an extension in membership for the length of the closure.

Monterey Centre will not be accessible to the public during the closure.

The Oak Bay Public Library and Oak Bay Volunteer Services will be open during the Monterey Centre closure.

New Building Exterior Signage

In 2024, the Oak Bay Parks, Recreation and Culture department underwent a branding review, with a new logo developed to align more closely with the District of Oak Bay's logo and branding.

At Monterey Recreation Centre, four signs will be replaced:

- o The two-way cedar entrance sign on Monterey Avenue
- o The fascia sign above the entrance to Monterey Recreation Centre
- o The cedar sign on Hampshire Road
- o The two-way sign on Oak Bay Avenue near the walkway
